

CORNWALL HANDGUN CLUB RANGE 1 RULES

All members and their guests must register in the appropriate range log book

Eye and ear protection shall be mandatory for all shooters and spectators in reasonable proximity of the shooting line

The red flag is to be posted when the range is active - no person shall go forward of the firing line on Range 1 while the red flag is posted

The green flag is to be posted to indicate a ceasefire - no person shall handle a firearm when the green flag is posted

Firearms must be pointed down range at all times

It shall be the responsibility of each member to ensure that they and their guests follow all safety rules and procedures while on the range property

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY

If someone is injured, seek medical attention immediately - call 911 and quote the civic location: "Highway 138, number 4395" to report an INJURY, not a shooting

HOURS

Range 1 is open seven days a week from 9 am until dusk for handguns & handgun-calibre rifles, and muzzle loaders

Shotguns may only be used Monday to Saturday, 9 am until dusk – no Sunday shooting

CALIBRES

Handguns, handgun-calibre rifles, muzzleloaders up to .75 calibre, and shotguns may be used on this range, subject to HOURS above – no high-power rifles on this range

TARGETS

Only targets approved by the Club executive may be used - no glass or explosive targets allowed

Target stands must be placed at the base of the backstop such that bullets & slugs strike the backstop and not the range floor

Approved metal targets shall be surrounded by wooden shrouds, and engaged at a distance of 10 meters or more
