



## **CORNWALL HANDGUN CLUB RIFLE RANGE 3 RULES**

All members and their guests must register in the appropriate range log book

Eye and ear protection shall be mandatory for all shooters and spectators in reasonable proximity of the shooting line

The red flag is to be posted when the range is active - no person shall go forward of the firing line on Range 3 while the red flag is posted

The green flag is to be posted to indicate a ceasefire - no person shall handle a firearm when the green flag is posted

Firearms must be pointed down range at all times

It shall be the responsibility of each member to ensure that they and their guests follow all safety rules and procedures while on the range property

### **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY**

If someone is injured, seek medical attention immediately - call 911 and quote the civic location: "Highway 138, number 4395" to report an INJURY, not a shooting

### **HOURS**

Range 3 is open seven days a week from 9 am until dusk for handgun calibre rifles and muzzle loaders

Shotguns and high-powered rifles may only be used Monday to Saturday, 9 am until dusk – no Sunday shooting

### **CALIBRES**

Handgun calibre rifles, muzzle loaders up to .75 calibre, shotguns using slugs, and high-power rifles less than .50BMG may be used on range 3, subject to HOURS above

- NO HANDGUNS on this range

### **TARGETS**

Targets must be placed no higher than 6 feet above the range floor, near the base of the backstop such that bullets & slugs strike the backstop and not the range floor - no cans, steel, glass or explosive targets allowed on this range
