

General Rules for ALL ranges at the Cornwall Handgun Club.

The Last person leaving the range is to close and lock the gate. Individuals may lock the gate behind them while they are shooting alone at the range.

Don't pass on the gate code to non-members.

Your club card should be worn at all times on the ranges.

No person shall attend the range facility while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

There must always be a "Range Officer." If you are shooting alone, YOU'RE IT.

Just like restricted firearms, your sporting rifles and shotguns will be transported to the range ENCASED. A blanket or a garbage bag will do if you don't have a case yet.

Firearms on range 3 (rifle range) will be uncased on the firing line on a RED flag.

The trunk of your car or truck is not a safety area. You do not walk across the parking lots with an uncased firearm in your hands.

Do not shoot at signs, posts, or other non-target items.

Failure to follow any and all range rules may result in disciplinary measure, suspension of shooting privileges, or dismissal from the Club.

Clean up after yourself. Old targets and spent steel casings in the garbage. Spent brass in the brass bucket.
